431 Ministries

431 Ministries is a Springhill-based organization that supports the overlooked and underserved women in the community. Through counseling, side-by-side partnerships, and other outreaches, 431 helps women to experience confidence, hope-filled independence, and know that they are known, seen, and loved.

4:13 Strong

4:13 Strong is a 6-8 month residential program that provides men with both the opportunity and the tools to succeed personally and professionally.

Brightstone

BrightStone is a lifelong learning program for adults who live each day with developmental disabilities. BrightStone's mission is to provide a comprehensive work, social support, and future residential community for adults with special needs, expanding their potential and helping them to develop mentally, physically, socially, emotionally, and spiritually.

Franktown Open Hearts

Franktown works to bring physical and spiritual hope to low-income youth within Williamson County by instilling in them critical life skills. Franktown provides academic assistance, mentoring, recreation, and spiritual growth opportunities for youth, Kindergarten through 12th grade, in the form of weekly educational and vocational classes.

GraceWorks

GraceWorks Ministries offers wrap-around services, including food, shelter and support programs, to a large number of individuals and families in need around Williamson County.



Homeless Alliance

The Homeless Alliance provides assistance by sheltering those experiencing homelessness through emergency, temporary, transitional, and permanent housing solutions.

Hope Clinic

Hope Clinic for Women is a faith-based, safe, and confidential place equipping women, men, and families. They provide medical care, professional counseling, education classes, case management, mentorship, and practical support for unplanned pregnancies, women's healthcare, pregnancy loss, and postpartum depression.

HopeKids

The mission of HopeKids is to provide families with a restored hope and to transform the lives of children with life-threatening medical conditions. Through donations and fundraiser events they are able to reach and support families and have the opportunity to share the truth of the Gospel with them.
