






The buildings are the tools, the people are the vision.



The Middle School Mission Trip is based in and around the Nashville area. We have the privilege of partnering with local organizations like The Bridge, The Well Outreach, Second Harvest Food Bank, ShowerUp, and Dream Streets, which serve the community by providing food for those with food insecurities, restoring dignity to the homeless, and investing in educational opportunities for the next generation.

Appalachia, KY

Fifteen High school students and 4 adult leaders spent a week in Southeast Kentucky, partnering with Thirst Mission Organization and Happy Church to serve the local community! Ministry in Appalachia takes place in some of the most beautiful, yet poor, counties in the United States. During the week our team served the community through distributing blessing bags to those in need, helping with clean up efforts in the wake of flooding, leading a youth night and Bible quiz club, as well as serving at a local senior center.

Your Faithfulness is Transforming Lives in the Amazon

Thanks to your generosity, Justice & Mercy International continues to equip and encourage Indigenous pastors, support vulnerable families, and expand the reach of the Gospel throughout the Brazilian Amazon.

In 2024, JMI hosted three Jungle Pastors' Conferences, offered biblical training, discipleship tools, and spiritual refreshment to hundreds of local leaders. In a region where 80% of the state of Amazonas lacks a Gospel presence, these gatherings help pastors feel less isolated, more equipped, and empowered to serve in remote jungle villages.



This year also marked a major step forward in JMI's expansion into the largely unreached western Amazonas. In the city of Tefé, we launched a new child sponsorship program, welcomed our first mission team, and celebrated the graduation of the first cohort from a three-year theology training course—pastors now better equipped to carry the Gospel deeper into the jungle. A second cohort, located even further west, will begin training in the fall of 2025 as part of our long-term commitment to investing in local leaders.

In the village of Makuitá, we rejoiced over the completion of a new school for Pastor Belino and his community. It stands as a beacon of hope and opportunity for local families. Additionally, more than 600 Bibles and thousands of food bags and hygiene kits were given to families in need throughout the jungle, meeting physical and spiritual needs.



Finally, this year, JMI also established a new headquarters in Manaus and commissioned our first full-time missionary to the Amazon: former RHCC staff member, Anna Townsend. Thanks to Rolling Hills' ongoing investment, hundreds of children and families across the Amazon region are receiving consistent support, supplies, and the hope of Christ. Your faithfulness is cultivating lasting transformation in one of the most remote regions on Earth.

Your Generosity is Changing the Future for Moldova's Most Vulnerable

In Moldova, Justice & Mercy International continues to bring stability, hope, and the love of Christ to vulnerable children and teens.

This winter, your generosity helped launch a hugely successful emergency initiative to keep families warm during an energy crisis that gripped the region. In rural villages where people had resorted to burning trash indoors just to survive the cold, JMI delivered coal and other essential heating resources. Hundreds of families were able to safely heat their homes and experience the warmth of God's provision when they needed it most.



At the same time, JMI renewed its commitment to minister to Ukrainian refugees who continue to arrive in Moldova in desperate need of safety, hope, and healing. Through partnerships with local churches, we have provided food, shelter, and spiritual support to those who have lost everything. These efforts offer both immediate relief and long-term connection to the body of Christ.

Throughout the year, JMI's Vulnerable Child program has provided critical support to children living in deep poverty, offering school supplies, clothes, medical care, and, most importantly, the opportunity to hear and respond to the Gospel. With the support of sponsors and donors, more than a thousand young people are receiving ongoing care and encouragement. Monthly gatherings—hosted in partnership with local churches—create space for joy and connection through games, songs, Bible teaching, and the chance to write to and hear from their sponsors.

JMI's Transitional Living program remains one of our most impactful ministries, providing homes, counseling, education, and life skills to dozens of high-risk teens. Many of these youth are susceptible to human trafficking, and this program helps them stay safe and build a future grounded in faith and purpose.

This year, we also celebrated several key milestones in Moldova, including welcoming Vadim Fortuna as National Director, as well as the opening of new offices in both Chisinau and Balti. In addition, we hosted multiple mission trips and summer camps, with Rolling Hills team members joining us on the ground to serve and encourage our local staff and communities.

Your generosity is helping to change the future for the most vulnerable children and teens in Moldova, raising up a new generation of Christian leaders. Thank you for offering safety, support, and the truth of God's love to those who need it most.


Last October marked our first ever Rolling Hills Revival, and God moved in incredible ways. Lives were changed, hearts were transformed, and faith was renewed.

Wednesday night, the Franklin Campus was packed for a powerful message from Lisa Harper, with hundreds joining online. The altar was filled with names as prayers were lifted for salvation—an incredible move of God.

Thursday night, our Next Gen students and their supporters gathered for a night full of passion and purpose. The room was buzzing with energy, and many more joined in online to worship and grow in faith.

Friday brought sacred moments of unified prayer across all our campuses. People came ready to intercede—for their families, their friends, and our world—both in person and online.

Saturday, hundreds served as the hands and feet of Jesus in our city—at the Community Center, Nashville West Campus, The Refuge Center, and Johnson Elementary. It was the church in action, loving our neighbors.

Sunday was a true celebration. Thousands gathered across our campuses, with nearly a thousand more online. Tim Tebow asked those ready to follow Christ to raise their hands—and 61 people responded. And across our campuses, 63 people were baptized—boldly declaring their faith. That’s 124 life-changing decisions for Christ in one powerful day.


Core Values

“Serving with my God-given gifts feels like a personal conversation with my faithful Creator. When I give my whole self to serving Him, He shows me in unique ways that He sees me, loves me, and is with me — like a hidden gift in a child’s honest compliment or a truth I needed to hear myself.



When I served in Brazil with JMI, two teammates reminded me deeply of loved ones on my heart — one who had passed away — showing me just how personal His gifts can be.

What may seem like a simple task — stacking chairs, wiping a nose, sharing a verse — can become someone else’s needed reminder, encouragement, or even an answered prayer. We may not always feel ready, but with open hands and a willing heart, He will use us.

I don’t serve because I have to, but because I get to. Our gifts matter. When we use them, we strengthen our faith and join God in His work, worshipping Him with our lives. I get to share His love in ways only I can, and He rewards me in ways only He can give.

“I always believed there was something greater, even if I couldn’t name it. Science can explain much, but not the beginning of it all — the spark of life. I never had a clear sense of faith.

That changed in October 2023, when my life fell apart. My wife discovered my secret addiction to opiates. On the outside I was functioning; inside I was dying. In treatment, I feared I’d lose everything.

In total surrender, I prayed. I begged God to forgive me and stop the pain. Minutes later, I felt relief. That wasn’t luck — it was Him. I vowed never to go back.

Soon after, I heard two speakers share their stories of despair, sobriety, and redemption in Jesus. Their deep conviction struck me, planting hope exactly when I needed it most. Leaving treatment, I stayed committed: meetings, a sponsor, church every Sunday. Today, I’m 231 days sober. I still have my job, and most importantly, my family.

Now, I’m ready. I believe in Jesus Christ. I’m proud to join my wife in baptism to show I’ve given my life to God — and maybe inspire someone else who feels lost. I’ve watched Jeff lead at Rolling Hills, and his sermons have pushed me to be a better husband, father, and man. I deeply respect him, and there’s no one else I’d rather have baptize me.”

Giving All

Your Faithfulness Allows Rolling Hills to:

- Continue paying down debt and building a strong, fiscally responsible cash reserve
- Equip and empower skilled volunteers, helping us shift resources from maintenance to ministry
- Provide essential resources, including staff, supplies, facility upkeep, and administrative support

At our Franklin Campus, tenant income helps offset much of our mortgage. While we still cover our own utilities, this unique position allows more of your tithes and offerings to directly fuel ministry, mission efforts, and community outreach.

THE BUDGET PROCESS

1. Set next year's ministry strategy through prayer and discernment.
2. Determine goals and needed resources to implement these strategies.
3. Forecast giving for the current and upcoming year.
4. Start at \$0 and build a budget for ministry needs.
5. Ensure 2025-2026 strategies are funded.
6. Present the 2025-2026 Budget to the Board of Directors and the Finance Team for review.
7. Make revisions if needed and present a final version of the budget to the Board and Finance Team for approval.



WHY DO WE GIVE?

Everything we have comes from God. Giving through tithes and offerings is an act of worship and spiritual discipline. It reflects our stewardship and desire to use what He's entrusted to us to glorify Him and grow His Kingdom. We naturally invest in what we value—where we spend our time, talents, and treasures shows the posture of our heart.

WHEN SHOULD WE GIVE?

Consistent giving reminds us of God's faithfulness and our dependence on Him. Whether you give weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly—through a recurring gift, offering basket, or mail—let it be a moment of worship and trust.

WHAT SHOULD WE GIVE?

We use two terms: tithes and offerings. A tithe is 10% of income (Leviticus 27:30; Malachi 3:10) and serves as a faithful starting point. Jesus, who gave everything, calls us to even greater generosity. Offerings are gifts above the tithe, given during special opportunities like capital campaigns or designated initiatives.
